

Where Your Funds Will Go: OneFamily Therapeutic Youth Camps in Israel



The funds raised through this event will be targeted to OneFamily Fund Therapeutic Youth Camps. Throughout the year, during Chanukah, Pesach and Summer vacation, OneFamily provides sleep-away camps for children who have been affected by terror. These vulnerable youth take part in a well-balanced variety of both fun and therapeutic activities.

- Fun and leisure activities: The aim of this component of the camp is for children to experience happiness and to acquire the release needed to prepare the ground for deeper therapeutic work. Activities include hiking, jeep tours, amusement park visits, swimming and cultural events.
- O Therapeutic activities: The goal of these activities is for participants to learn how to deepen relationships, process significant emotional issues, make personal connections and feel empowered to share their internal worlds through experiences. The children participate in such activities as movement and music workshops, cooking classes, hydrotherapy and expressive arts.

As well, counselors and therapists lead activities designed to develop direct dialogue on issues of loss and bereavement, memory, longing, pain and difficulties dealing with family and friends as a result of the bereavement or trauma. It costs \$1,000 for every young victim of terror to attend a youth camp.
